For example, the “Acting - Actors/Actresses (misc/other)” list does not contain items included on available lists for individual actors/actresses – Charlie Chaplin and Marilyn Monroe. The same is true for animals, presidents, kings, etc. See ATA’s Topical Checklist listing on our website for groupings of items related to the “misc/other” lists.

Checklists marked with an asterisk(*) contain Beyond the Catalogue (BTC) items: Basic types of common philatelic items issued by governments but not usually listed in Scott Standard Postage Stamp Catalogue, e.g., booklet covers, meter stamps, postal cards, postal stationery, postmarks.
