CHESSE

The Chess on Stamp Study Unit (COSSU) maintains two checklists, both prepared by Jim McDevitt, which are free to all on its web site <<http://www.chessonstamps.org>>

CAPTAIN COOK

DISNEY

EUROPA

The Europa Study Unit has checklists available in a Handbook. Besides the annual Europa issues, the handbook includes the European Recovery Program, NATO, Nordic Cooperation, Council of Europe, BENELUX, etc. The cost is \$15 from: Europa Study Unit; Don Smith; PO Box 576; Johnstown PA 15907-0576.

LIGHTHOUSES

The Lighthouse Stamp Society has a two-volume checklist. It covers lighthouse stamps in Volume 1 and buoys, lightships, duck stamps, local posts, bogus issues, stationery and more in Volume 2. The hard copy edition is \$25 postage paid to the US. For \$20 an electronic revision of the list is available in excel format via email. The list can be ordered from the Lighthouse Stamp Society, 8612 W. Warren Ln, Lakewood, CO 80227. Payment can be made by check or via Pay Pal by adding \$1 to help cover fees. Non-society members pay an additional \$5 for the list in either format.

MAPS/CARTO-PHILATELIC

The CartoPhilatelic Society maintains a 40,000 item checklist, "Maps on Stamps," of approximately 750 printed pages. The list is available to Carto-Philatelic Study Unit members in Excel format for \$35 everywhere; in hardcopy for \$50 to U.S. addresses; elsewhere for \$35 + actual postage. The Penguins on Stamps Study Unit offers a current Penguins checklist by Country - Species - Scientific Name, which is updated quarterly in its newsletter. Membership in the study unit is required; a fresh copy of the checklist is annually distributed to members.

ROTARY

Rotary on Stamps has an annually updated color illustrated catalog of Rotary issues available in hardcopy or pdf formats. Order from publications@rotaryonstamps.org or from glfitz@suddenlink.net. The cost is \$25 plus shipping.

SPORTS
